New Words. Deeper Meaning. Same Mass.

On the First Sunday of Advent, this year, we will be praying and singing the words of the revised English translation of the People's Parts of the Mass. This will be our first step, as members of the New Zealand Church, towards receiving the full English text of the Roman Missal at Pentecost, 2011.

These 'new words' which we will pray, are the fruit of a revision of the Latin text of the Mass which used a different principle of translation from Latin to the English language; the principle of formal equivalence. ***The words will sound familiar, yet they will be different.***

While it is rare for ritual language to change, some of us will remember praying the Mass in Latin. All of us have become deeply familiar with the texts of the Mass that we have prayed with in English, for almost forty years now. The new words of our prayer will require our close attention until they too become familiar to us. Take a fresh look at the booklet, *New Words. Deeper Meaning. Same Mass. Understanding the Revised Mass Texts*. This will help you to prepare for the First Sunday of Advent.

Through our attention to these new words and this significant unfolding in the prayer life of the Church, may we become *One Body, One Spirit in Christ: Kia Kotahi Ā-Tinana Ā-Wairua i roto i te Karaiti.*
